Lament

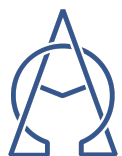
SCRIPTURE

THEME

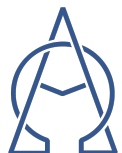
Peace

(from the Nunc Dimittis, Luke 2:30–32)

PRAYER

Joy to the world, ²the Lord is come!
